

School-Based Health Clinics

The goals of CREC school-based health services are:

- To increase student health and wellness
- To minimize lost classroom time
- To provide support to families who find it difficult to access healthcare during the school year

What are school-based health services?

- CREC's school-based health services staff is comprised of a nurse practitioner, a school nurse, a mental health clinician, and administrative staff.
- CREC works collaboratively with your child's primary care provider to promote continuity of care.

CREC's nurse practitioner offers:

- Physical examinations for school or sports
- Immunizations
- Diagnosis and treatment of common illnesses, such as a sore throat, an ear infection, or acne
- Management of chronic conditions, such as asthma and diabetes
- Diagnosis and treatment of minor injuries
- Individual and group health promotion and education
- Reproductive health services

CREC's licensed clinician offers:

- Counseling and mental health services
- Individual, group, and family therapy
- Crisis intervention
- Parent guidance
- Behavioral counseling

Other facts about CREC school-based health services include:

- Services are free.
- CREC takes many forms of insurance and will bill your insurance directly.
- CREC does not require co-pays and will never send you a bill—even if the insurance company doesn't pay for the service, or if you have a high-deductible plan.
- No student is ever turned away due to lack of insurance or lack of payment from an insurance company.
